

SOURDOUGH SAMS
IDAHO CHAPTER OF THE GOOD SAM CLUB
STANDING RULES
ADOPTED 9/30/2015

Name

This Chapter shall be known as the Sourdough Sams, a non-profit Idaho Good Sam Organization Chapter, which shall recognize the Constitution, Bylaws, and Pledge of the Good Sam Club and its Idaho State Organization Standing Rules as its own.

Purpose

The purpose of the Chapter shall be to promote the use and enjoyment of recreational vehicles and outdoor fellowship among its members, and to maintain an attitude which is non-sectarian, non-partisan, non-sectional and non-racial.

Membership

This chapter is considered as “at-large” and membership is not restricted to a specific locale. All members shall be paid and in good standing with the Good Sam Club and with the Sourdough Sams. Each membership includes one couple or single and any dependents living with them.

Emblem

The chapter colors are light brown and dark brown and the logo is a picnic table with a couple eating pancakes.

Dues

Chapter dues shall be established by the simple majority vote and as of this date are \$10.00 annually. Dues will be paid no later than October each year, in order that the state portion can be submitted in a timely fashion.

Officers

Officers of the Chapter shall be the President, Vice-President, Secretary/Treasurer, and Wagonmaster. Each officer shall hold office for 2 (two) years and shall be elected in odd numbered years at the State Fall Meeting. The President will appoint a nominating committee which shall present the slate of officers to the membership with nominations accepted from the floor.

President – Will preside at all meetings, appoint all committees, supervise Chapter activities and will represent the Chapter at State functions or appoint a proxy to attend. Any Chapter property shall be kept by the President during his/her term.

Vice President – Will conduct meetings in the absence of the President and will coordinate committee activities.

Secretary/Treasurer – Will record meeting minutes, the time, place and attendance of each meeting. The Secretary shall maintain the membership roster, receive, read and answer all correspondence at the direction of the membership and President. Will have custody of all

funds, and shall keep full and accurate records of receipts and disbursements and will furnish a report to the membership. All debts shall be paid with check, signed by President and/or Treasurer.

Wagonmaster – Will organize Chapter campouts under the direction of the President, taking responsibility for selecting sites and coordination of activities. This position may be appointed or elected.

Voting

Each adult family member shall be entitled to 1 (one) vote, and the President shall only vote in the event of a tie. Only Chapter members in good standing may address the Chapter on matters of policy, and a simple majority of those members present will be required for voting purposes.

Meetings

Meetings shall be held during the 3 (three) State gatherings each year, normally in April, June and September, but can be altered when appropriate at the discretion of the President and the membership.
